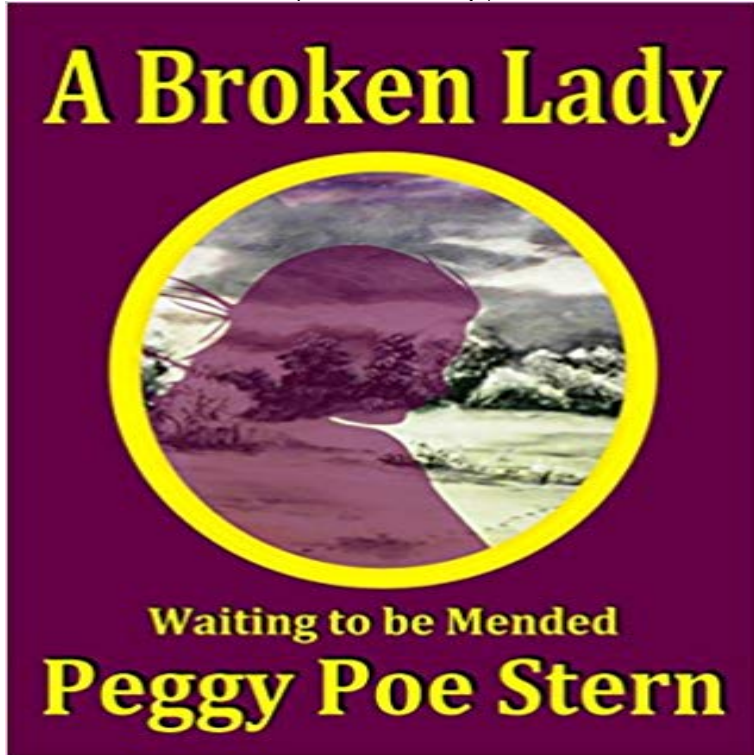


A Broken Lady: Waiting to be Mended
