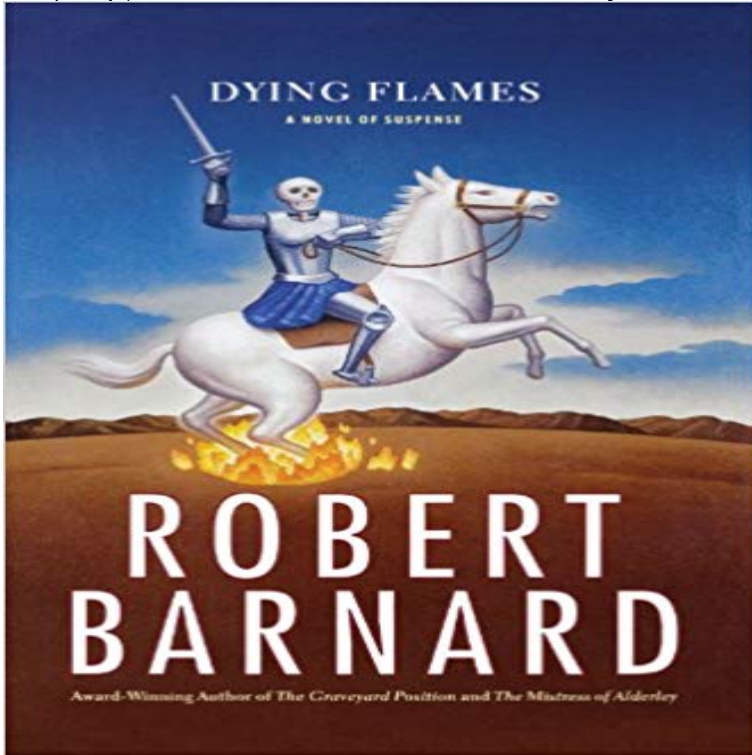


Dying Flames: A Novel of Suspense

The sins of the past return to haunt the living, and the lives of those who survive will never be the same.
