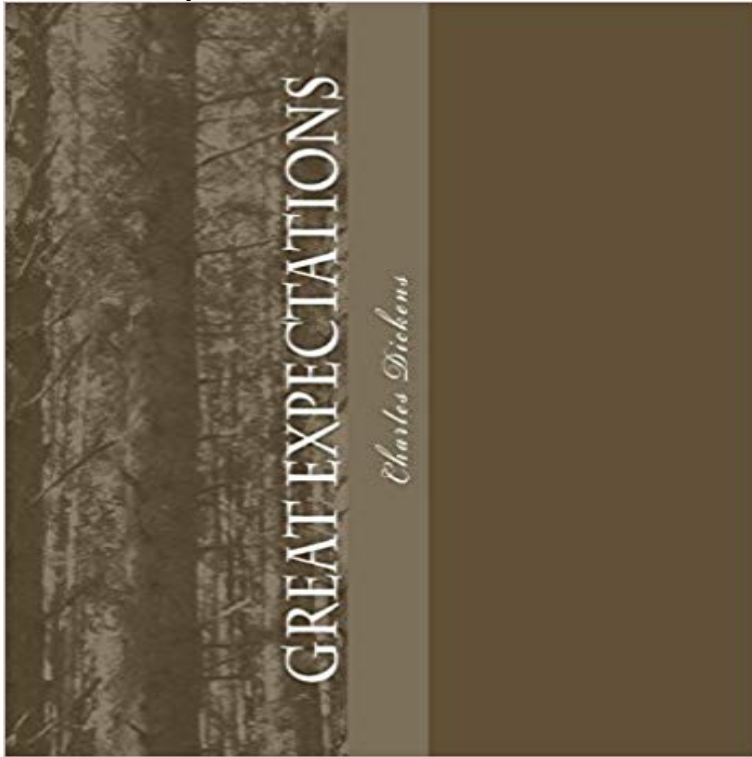


# Great Expectations
