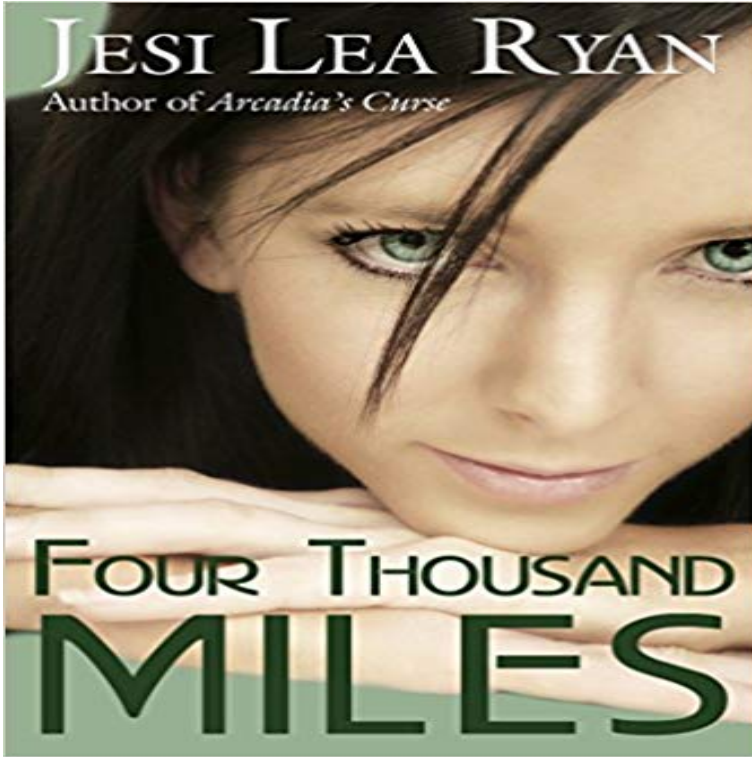


Four Thousand Miles
