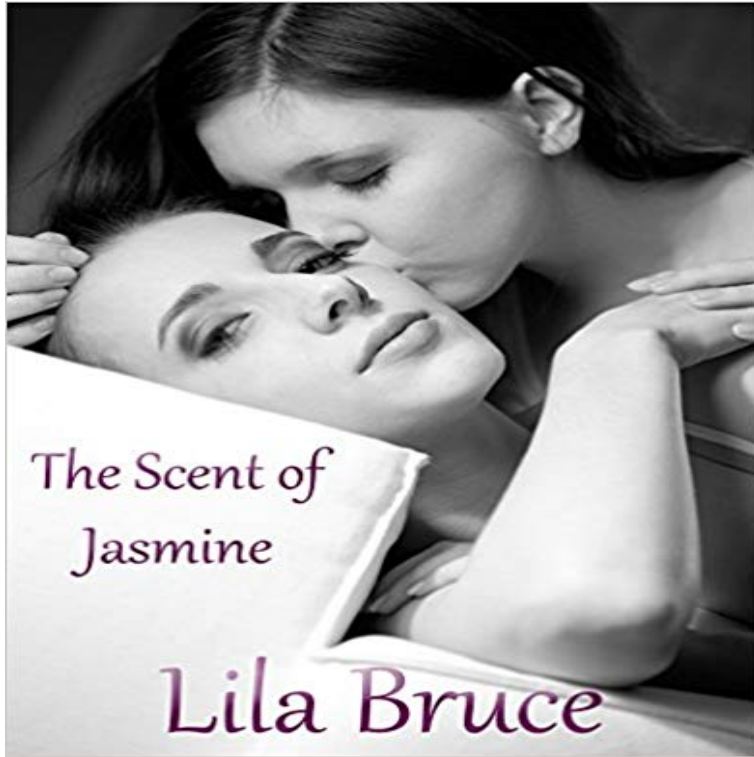


The Scent of Jasmine
