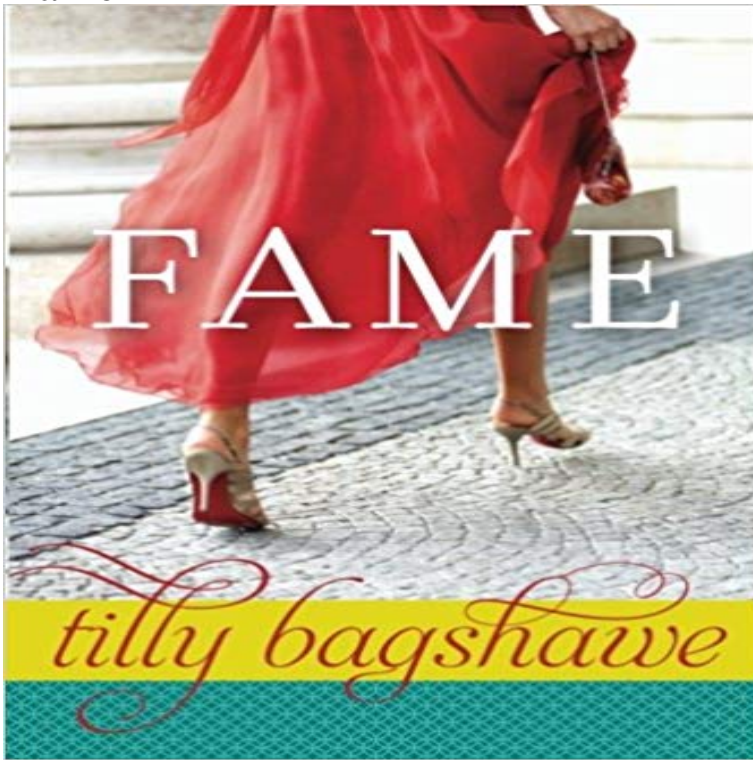


Fame
